This leaflet contains a map of the village and information on local businesses and services. We hope it helps you.

Holme upon Spalding Moor was originally called Hemp Holme, as in the past the area grew hemp for rope making. It has since become an important village on the edge of the wolds hills in the vale of York. Located between Market Weighton and Howden and close to the market towns of Selby and Beverley, it is also well connected to the region's major cities of Hull and York and Leeds. Junction 37 of the M62 is just 8 miles away and Leeds is a 40 minute drive. York and Hull are 30 minutes away. Access to the M62 gives fast travel by car to the whole country.

The main geographical interest is the church of All Saints which sits on top of a hill which rises out of the otherwise very flat land. This is a well known landmark from miles around in all directions, and there is a superb view of surrounding land from the top; with York Minster and Howden Abbey standing out on the horizon on a clear day. At the base of the hill is Holme Hall, which is now a Sue Ryder nursing home. But at one time the manor and estate belonged to the Constables of Flamborough.

There is no longer a railway line in Holme (Howden and Selby are the closest), but the old trackbed which runs past the northern end of the village is now a popular walk and cycle track. Many other walks can be found in the nearby Wolds Hills including the well know "Wolds Way" long distance footpath which passes through Market Weighton.

During the war there was a bomber airfield in Holme (to the East of the village). Close links are still maintained with 76 and 458 Squadron.

The village has its own Primary School, a wide range of shops, a bank, several pubs and restaurants, and an excellent medical centre. There is also a very well equipped Village Hall and sports field.

Who are Holme Christian Fellowship?

We are a church made up of ordinary people who have found that knowing Jesus makes a big difference to our lives. We are growing as a family, with people from all ages and backgrounds. We aim to care for one another and serve the community in which we live.

We meet at 10.30 am every Sunday at the Scout Hall in the middle of the village. The meeting starts with a family time of praise and worship. The children then leave for their special time together while the adults continue with worship and a message. After the meeting we share refreshments together.

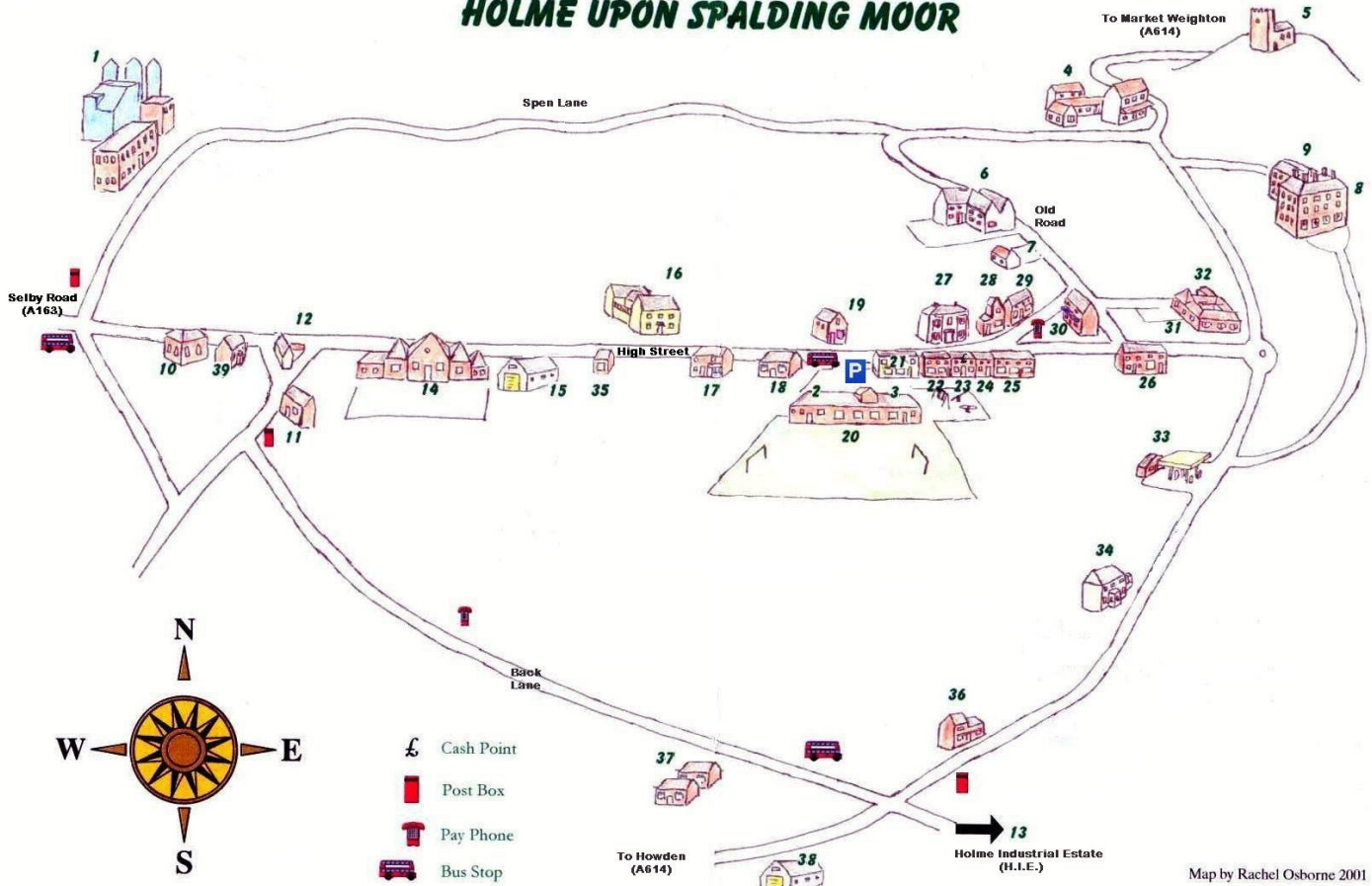

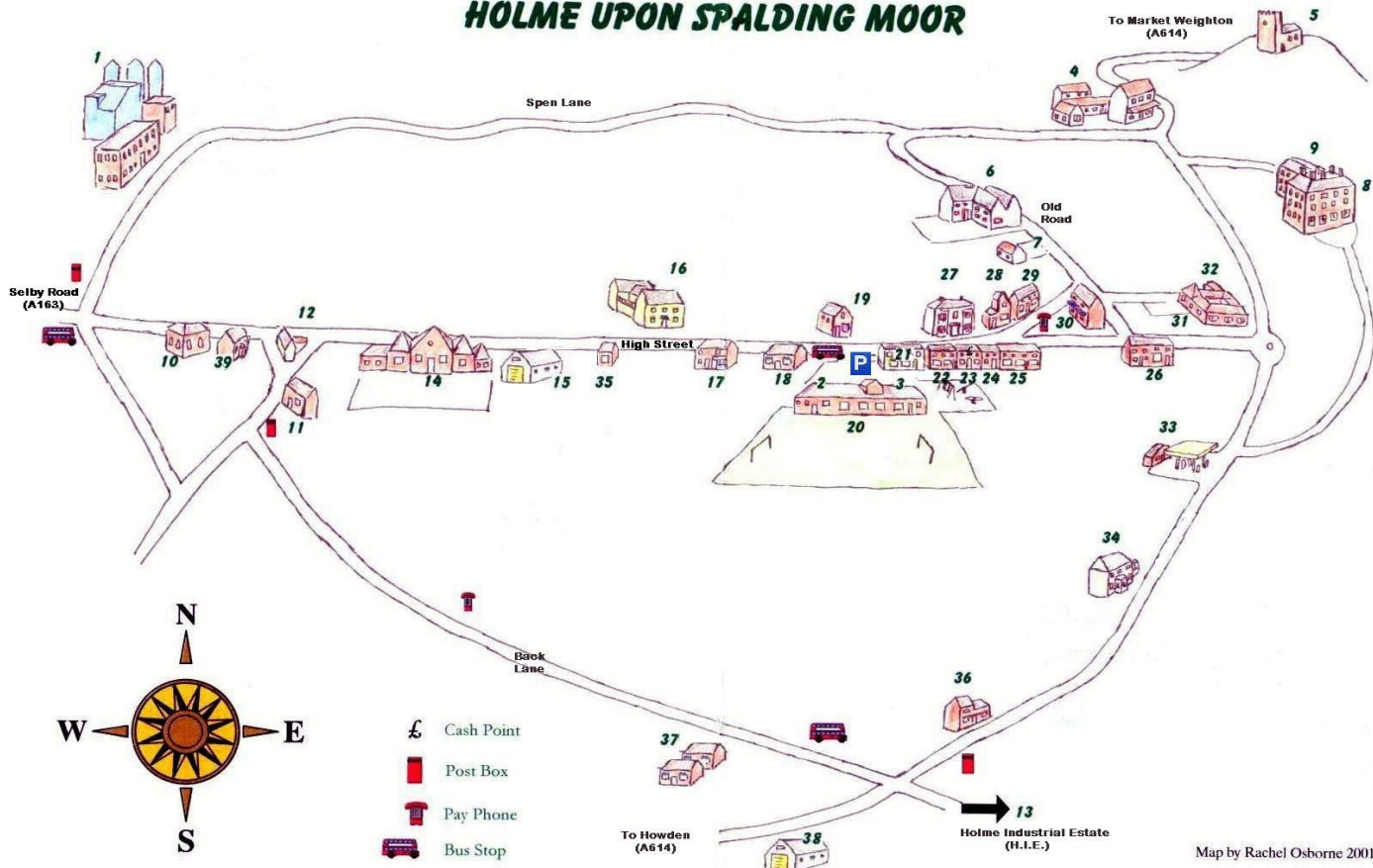

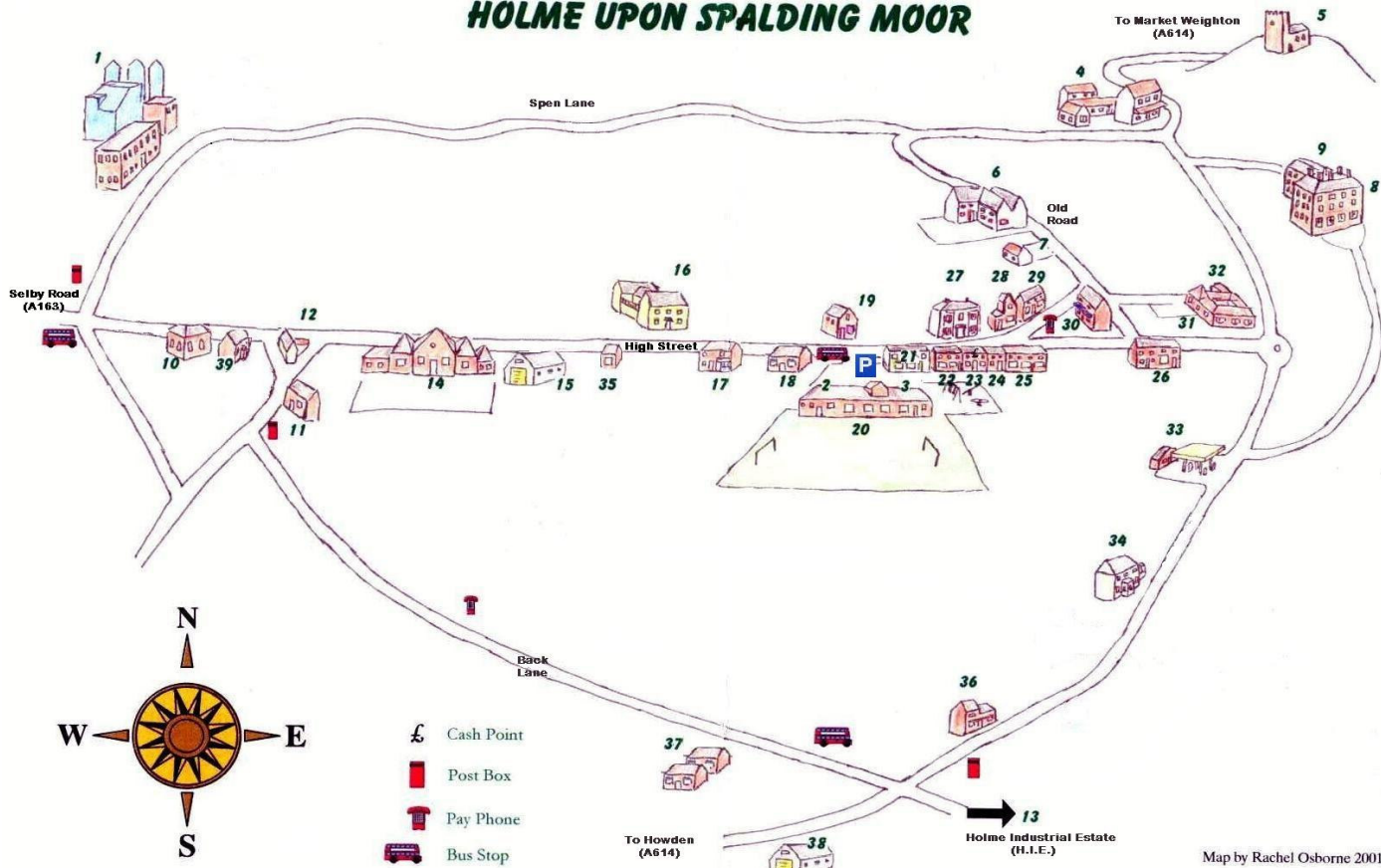
