



USE OF THE COMPUTERS IN THE CAFÉ

The two computers in the Café may be used free of charge to run software already installed on them provided that nobody has paid to use the Internet. If someone has paid to use the Internet then they will always take priority.

There will be a charge of £1 for all or part of an hour to use the Internet, payable in advance at the till. People using the Internet will be required to sign in, and a note will be made of the time that their use starts.

The maximum time anyone will normally be permitted to stay on the Internet is one hour unless there are no other people who want to use the Internet. Payment for all or part of a further hour must also be made in advance at the same rate of £1.

Users of the computers may print items from the computer on the strict understanding that they pay for all prints made. The cost of these are 5p per sheet for black and white prints, 50p per sheet for colour prints. If a user wants to make a print they need to inform one of the staff on duty who will personally go and collect the printout and receive the payment

Please note that:

- Food and drink may not be consumed when sitting near the computers.
- If the staff on duty at the Drop In Coffee Shop decide that a user of the computers is not following the rules or acting in an unacceptable manner they will be required to leave the premises.
- If any user is found to be sending or receiving abusive, provocative or any other material which is deemed unsuitable by the staff on duty they will be required to cease using the computers and/ or leave the premises.
- Users will be blocked from using Internet Chat Rooms or making large downloads.
- Whilst every attempt has been made by Holme Christian Fellowship to ensure that the Internet and the computers are available at all times when the Café is open, they cannot accept any liability if there are any computer or Internet malfunctions and cannot take any responsibility if any material on the computers is lost or corrupted.
